NFIP Extended to July 31

The President has signed legislation which includes an extension of the NFIP until July 31. This action averts a lapse of the NFIP's authority to write and renew federal flood insurance policies. Congress may be expected to resume discussions and debate regarding NFIP reform prior to July 31. As such, you may consider working with your government affairs department or appropriate trade association on outreach to Congress in support of positive reform to the program.
