



Flood Industry Alert

NFIP Extension

November 30, 2018

In advance of a potential lapse of the NFIP, Congress passed a seven-day extension of the Program late yesterday. The associated bill ([HR 7187](#)) is expected to soon be signed by the President. This latest extension pushes back the Program's expiration to December 7th, the same day federal government spending authority is set to expire. By that date, Congress must pass a funding bill to avoid a partial government shutdown, with the possibility that they will include a longer-term extension of the NFIP within the funding bill. The length of a subsequent extension is currently unknown, and other extension bills ([S 3628](#) and [S 3670](#)) have seen activity in the Senate this week.
