FEMA Bulletin on the New SFHDF

FEMA has just released a [bulletin](#) related to use of the new Standard Flood Hazard Determination Form (SFHDF). In the bulletin, FEMA affirms the message on its [website](#) that use of both the new form (FEMA Form 086-0-32) and the previous form (FEMA Form 81-93) are allowed until May 30, 2015.

As you may recall from one of our previous *Industry Alerts*, the significant changes to the form include reference to the collateral's "parcel number" and the LOMA/LOMR number (instead of the LOMA/LOMR date). Importantly, FEMA's current bulletin explains that the Parcel Number and LOMA/LOMR Case Number will not be required until 2015, even if a company transitions to the new form. FEMA also clarifies the Instructions for the SFHDF regarding these data fields, and announces that both versions of the SFHDF are available on its website.

In addition to the WYO Principal Coordinators and NFIP Servicing Agent, FEMA distributed its bulletin to the Federal Banking Regulatory Agencies, other Federal Agencies, the Government Sponsored Enterprises, and various Banking and Credit Union Associations.
