## Use of SFHDF

FEMA has posted an updated [notice](#) regarding the Standard Flood Hazard Determination Form (SFHDF) which indicates that the existing (Form 086-0-32) and prior (Form 81-93) versions of the SFHDF can continue to be used (including beyond May 30, 2015) until the new SFHDF becomes available. The notice also states that once the new SFHDF is published, additional information will be provided for users on transitioning to the new SFHDF. We will distribute a follow-up Industry Alert after the new SFHDF and transition information become available. In the meantime, we continue to [prepare](#) for incorporating the new SFHDF into our systems.
